

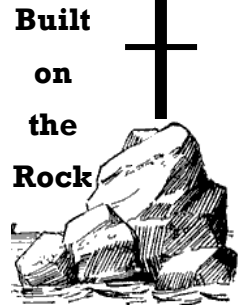

I will be sending book orders home this week. Please return them by next Friday. This is the second last book order of the year!

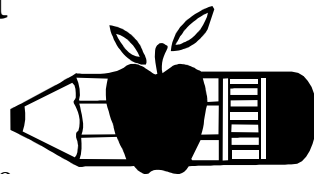

We have a busy few weeks coming up.



First of all, we have begun studying US Geography in Social Studies. We are taking a different region of the US each week and learning the states in that particular region and their respective capitals. I sent home a map yesterday with your child with the outline of each region we will be studying. Then each Friday, we will be taking a test on each region we studied that week. Second graders only need to know the states. Third graders need to know the states and their capitals. Fourth graders need to know states and capitals and how to spell them correctly to get it right. This week is the Northeast region of the US.

Test dates are as follows:

Northeast ~ April 16th

Southeast ~ April 23rd

Midwest ~ April 30th

Southwest ~ May 5th

Rocky Mts. ~ May 11

Pacific Coast ~ May 14
