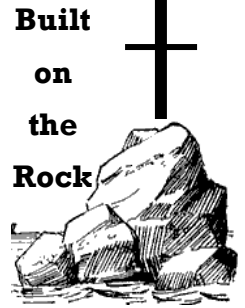




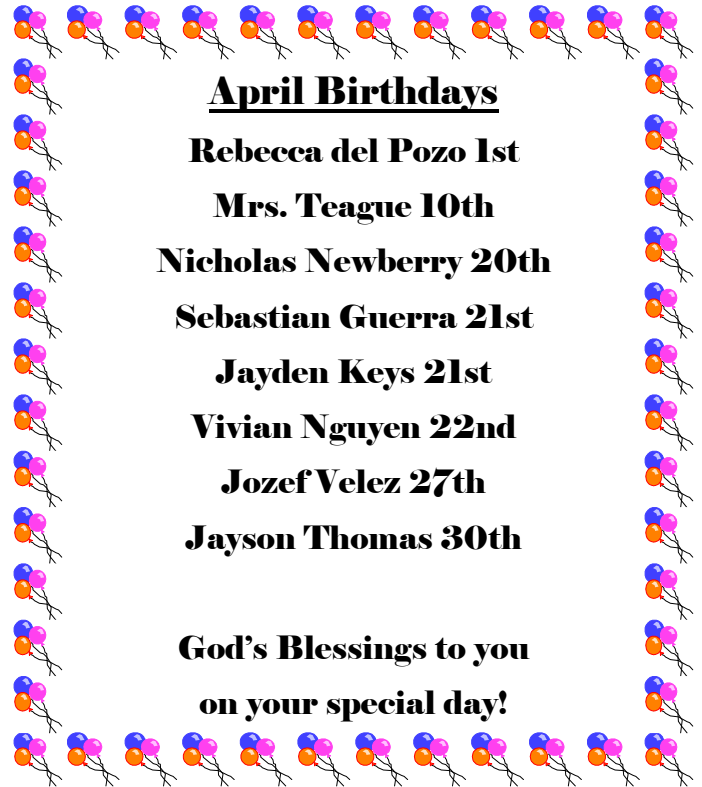
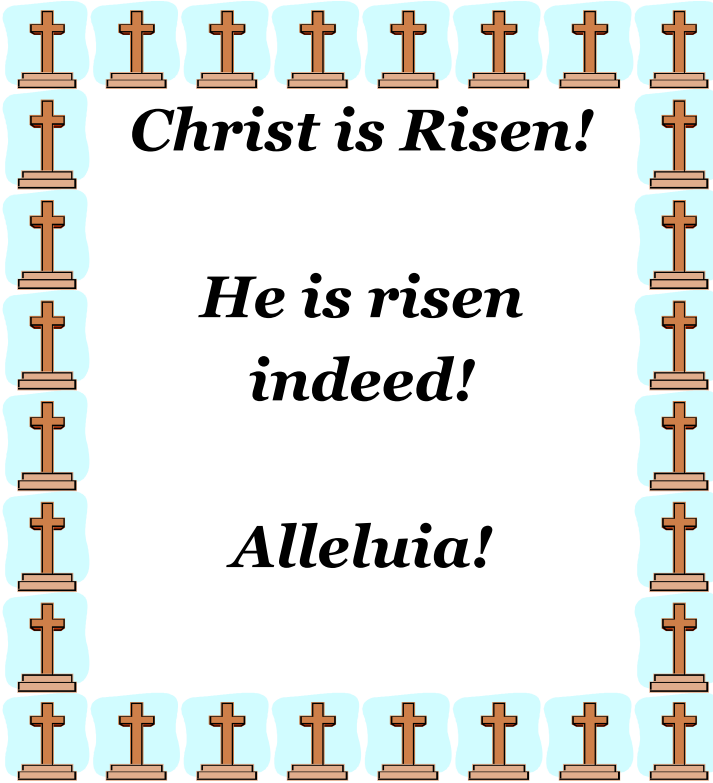

Our final book report is due Friday, April 30th. Keep in mind that our History fair projects are due Christ has risen! Alleluia!!

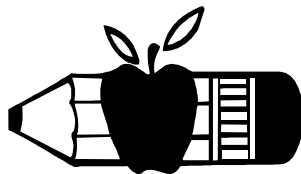
