Monday and Thursday-ChristLight binders

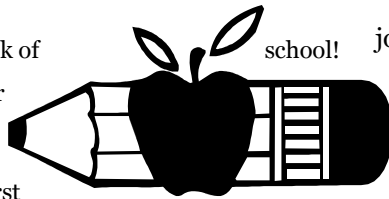
Please always check their folders and backpacks for work that they did not finish at school. Please complete and return the next day.

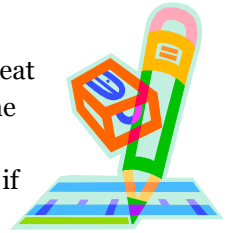
