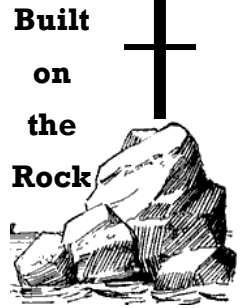




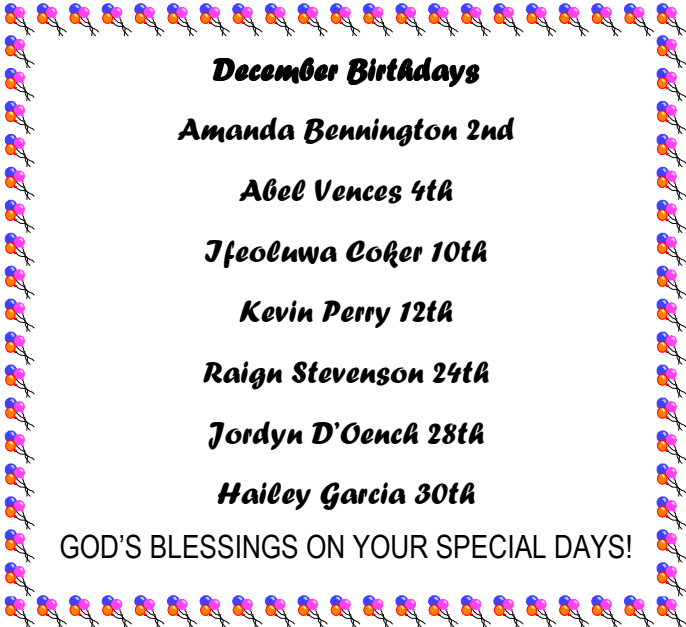

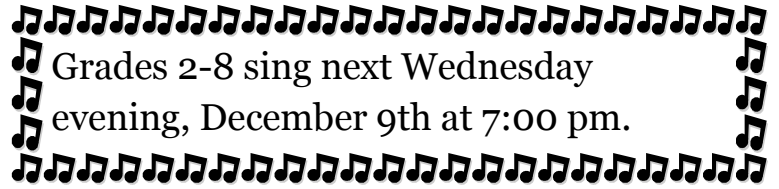

- Christmas Day Festival Service** at 10 a.m.



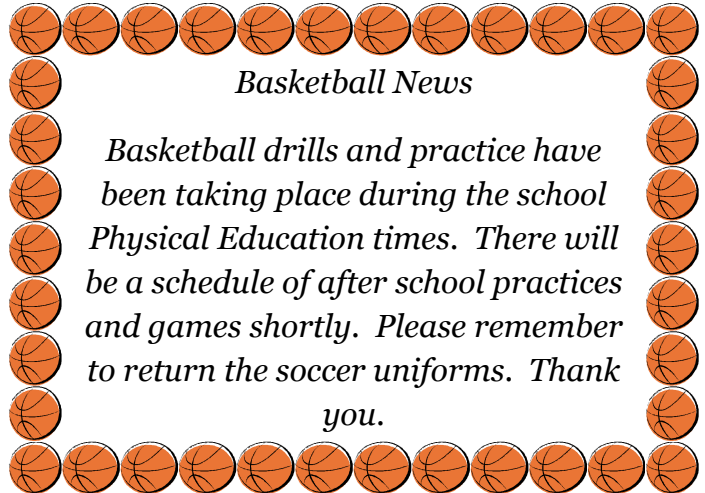

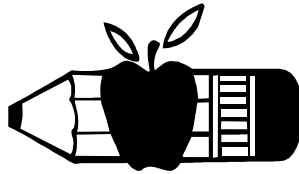
