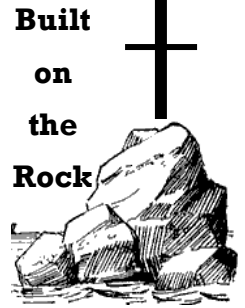

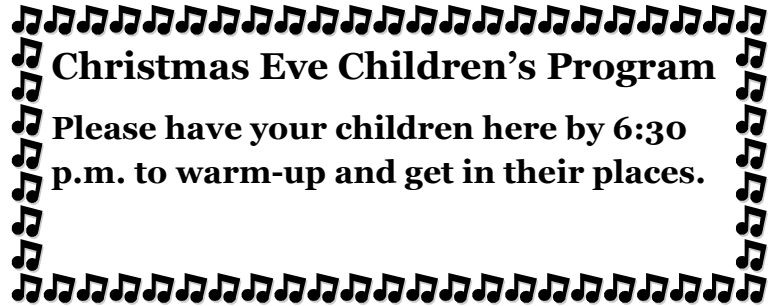

We are working hard on our Christmas Eve Service parts and songs. If your child is unable to be there on December 24th, please let me know as soon as possible.

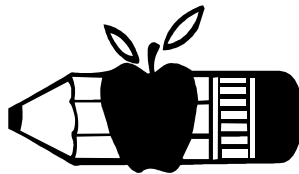
