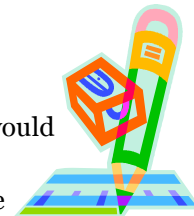

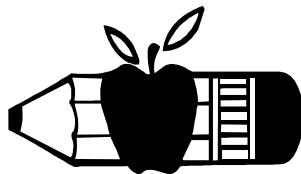
We will also be having our Geography terms test tomorrow. Please quiz your child using the landform circle they brought home yesterday.
