



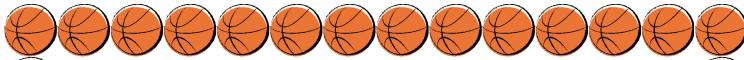
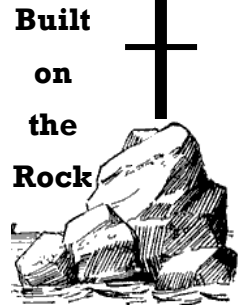

Next week is Spirit week as our basketball teams get ready for our tournament in Dallas. Your child is welcome to follow the dress-up days. (see front)

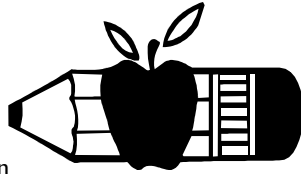
Book reports are due next Friday. (Basketball players and family members, please try to have it in on Thursday, so it doesn't get forgotten. Thanks!)
