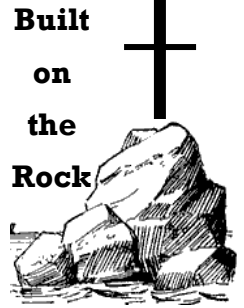

Sundays at 4:00pm in Sienna

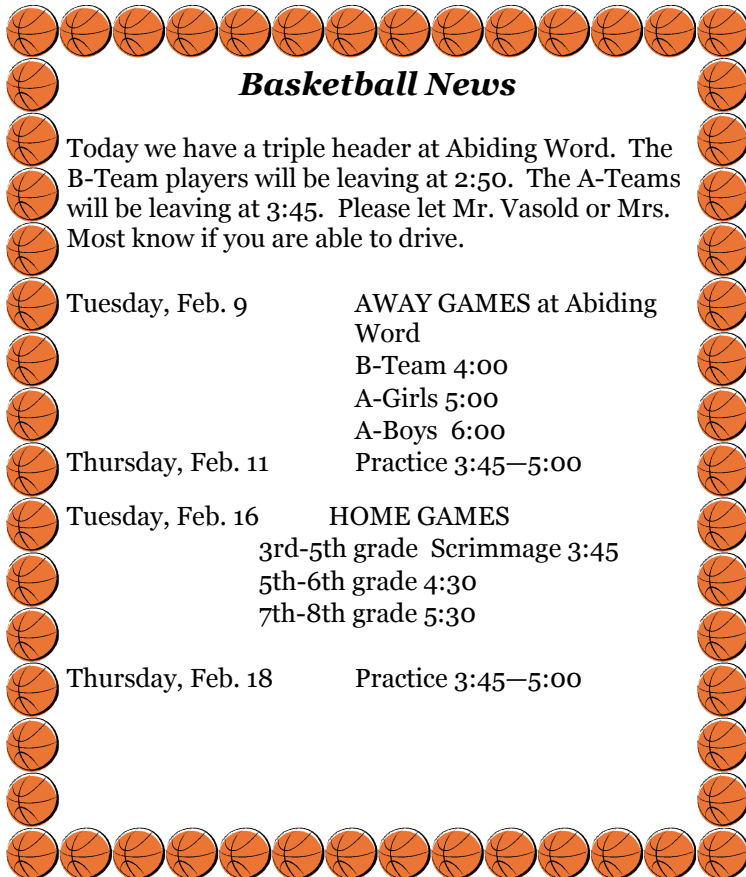
Fridays at 7:00pm in Alief (in Spanish)

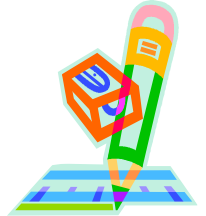
Grades 2-4 Dear Parents,
