

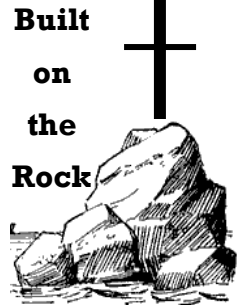

Gum Drops (2 packages needed)

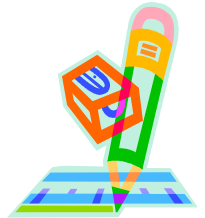

For art this week we will be making soap paint. If anyone has extra bars of soap lying around your house, we could use them for art! You can send them to school with your child as soon as possible.

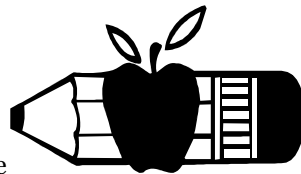
