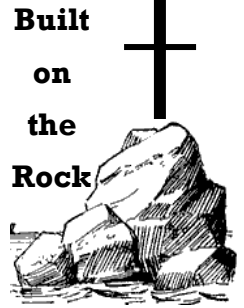

Dear parents,

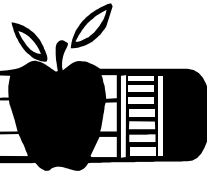
We welcome Sarah to our class! Sarah is a three-year-old, and brings our class total to 23 kids. Thanks for joining us, Sarah!
