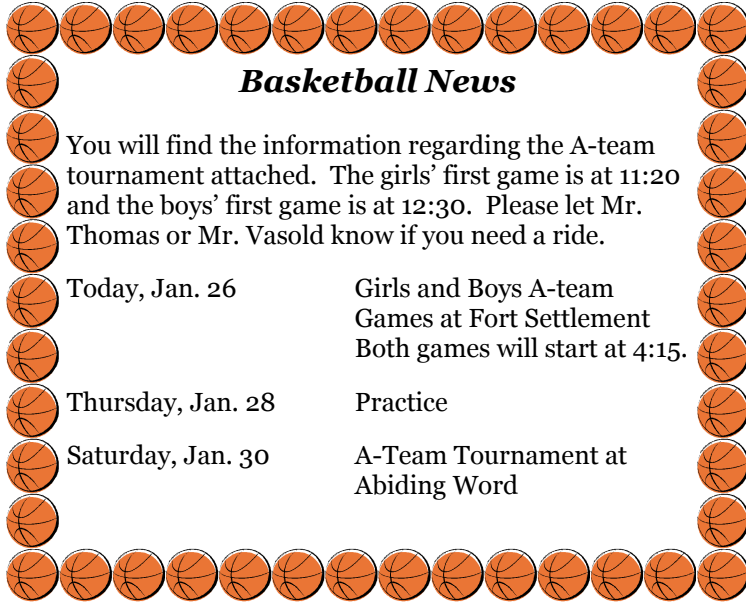
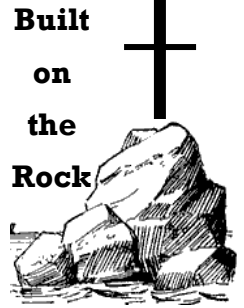

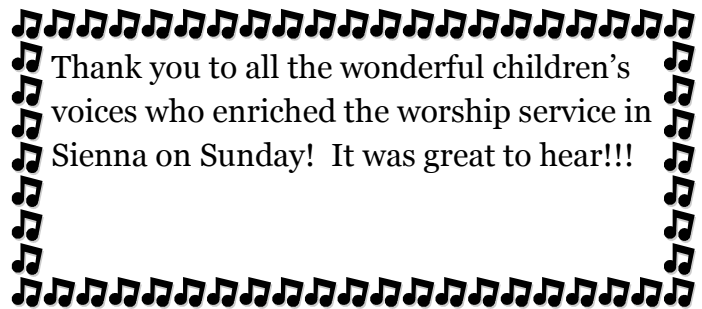
Students are also able to wear T-Shirts with a Christian theme.

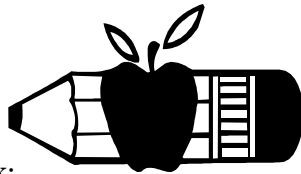
