

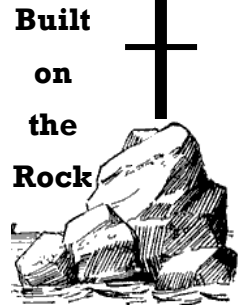

Book report forms were sent home yesterday with your child. They are due **April 30.**

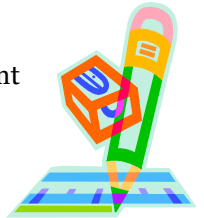
Report cards were also sent home yesterday. If you have any questions, I would be happy to answer them. Please remember to sign and return the envelope. Thank you!

1st grade spelling test (List #12) will be this Thursday!

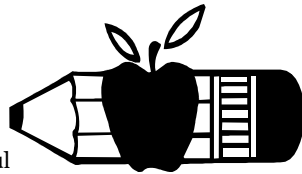
