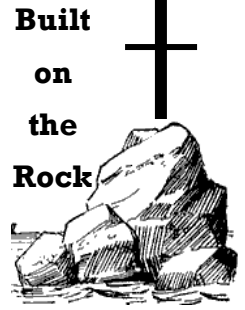

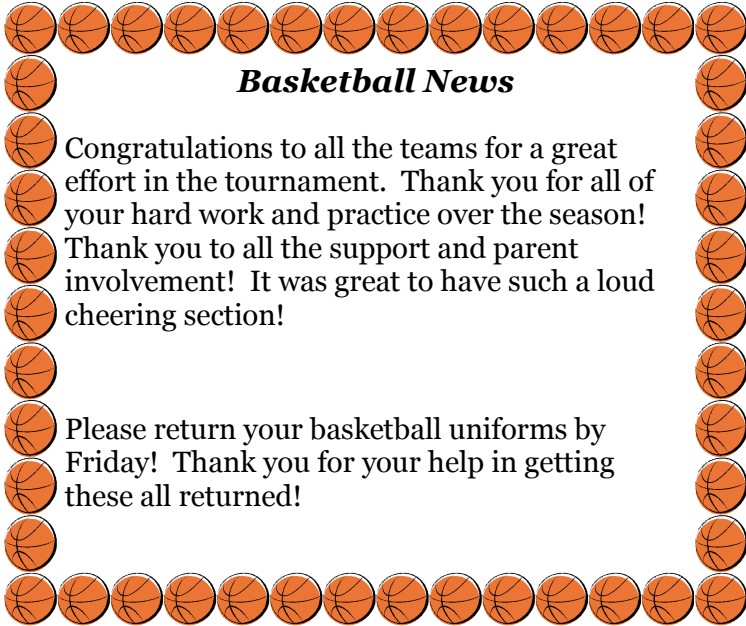

Please let the office know if any of your contact information has changed. Forms are available in the office, preschool and extended care rooms.

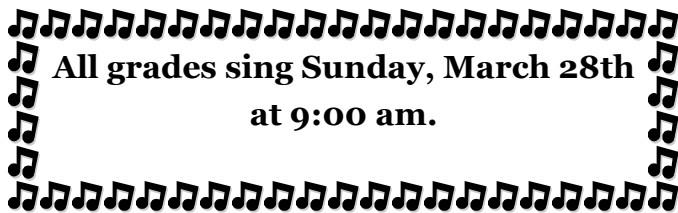
Reenrollment for 2010-2011

Book orders are in folders today. Please have them returned by **this Friday**, so that I can send them in before Spring Break!

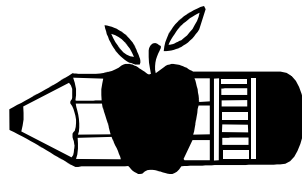
We are working on timelines in both ChristLight and Social Studies.
