

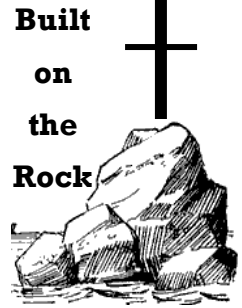

The picnic will start about 10:00 a.m., with lunch served at **11:00 a.m.***

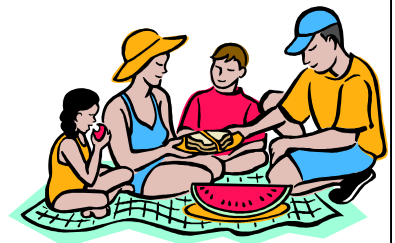

This Friday is the Spring Spectacular. Please arrive by 7:00pm. It should be a great time. The students have put in a lot of hard work.

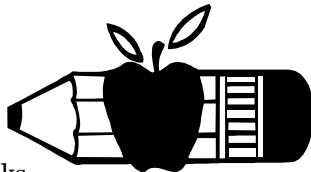
