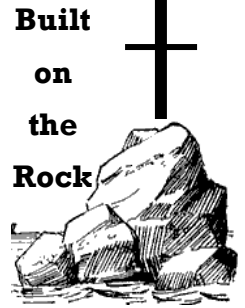

Final dismissal from school is **12:00 p.m.**

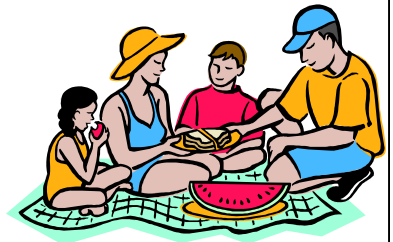
Parents that aren't able to make it to the picnic are asked to have their children picked up no later than 12:30 p.m. - there will be no extended care that afternoon.

Have a fantastic summer!

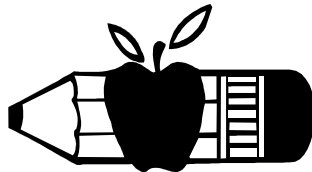
