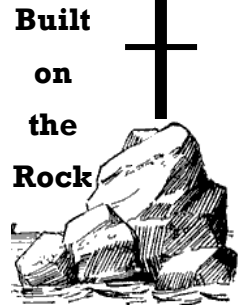

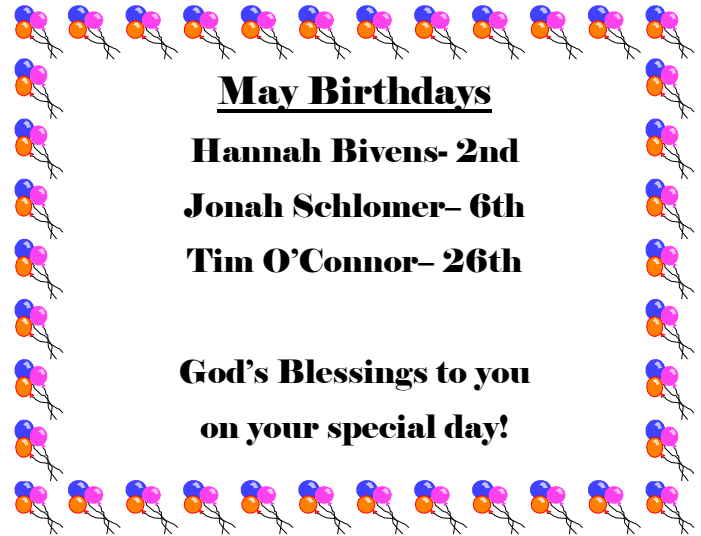
Graduation Day (kindergarten and 8th grade) -

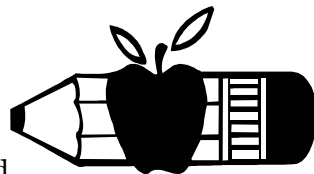
