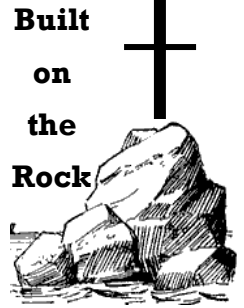

We are still short on classroom supplies of forks and spoons. If you can help us out by sending some in with your child, that would be great!

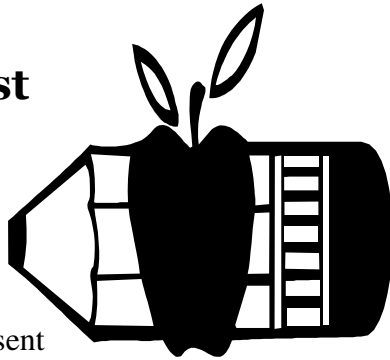
